## Boat Launch Agreement Winter Storage Boat Hauler

Pursuant to Article 43 of the Environmental Conservation Law and the Lake George Park Commission Aquatic Invasive Species Regulations, 6 NYCRR Subpart 646-9, the Lake George Park Commission (LGPC) and the Hauler set forth the following:

1. The Hauler Business Owner (hereinafter "Hauler") certifies that (she/he/it) is the owner/operator of a boat hauler business.
2. For the defined boating season, (May 1<sup>st</sup> – Nov. 1<sup>st</sup>) of each year, the Hauler is hereby authorized to launch any trailered vessel that has remained within the Hauler's care, custody and control since the previous boating season. A vessel that has remained in the Hauler's care, custody and control is defined as a vessel that has remained at a Commission authorized winter storage facility listed above, or at a separate parcel where the Hauler has provided sole transportation for the vessel via hydraulic lift and certifies the subject vessel has not been launched into any waterbodies aside from Lake George since the previous boating season.
3. Prior to launching any trailered vessels the Hauler shall provide the LGPC with a list (hereinafter "vessel manifest") of all vessels which it will haul during the boating season pursuant to this agreement, as well as the vessel make, model, state registration number, and the physical address where the vessel is stored for winter (example manifest attached hereto). This vessel manifest shall be attached hereto and incorporated herein. Modifications to a manifest may be made with written authorization from the Commission. The Hauler may only launch those boats listed on the vessel manifest under this agreement. Vessels not on that manifest would require inspection at one of the seven regional LGPC boat inspection facilities and receipt of a Vessel Inspection Control Seal (VICS).
4. During the period of May 1 through November 1 of each year, any trailered vessel that has not been in the Hauler's custody may not be launched into Lake George without inspection. Such vessel must travel to one of the LGPC regional inspection stations, and receive an inspection seal prior to launch in Lake George.

5. The Hauler and the Hauler employee(s) will ensure that all trailered vessels that are removed from Lake George meet the “cleaned, drained” standard.
6. The Hauler will maintain the vessel manifest registration and associated materials on its facility site for a period of three (3) years, and within all Hauler vehicles in the act of transporting a trailered vessel for launch on Lake George. Such forms shall be readily available for inspection upon request by the LGPC.
7. Failure to abide by the terms of this agreement and the LGPC regulations, 6 NYCRR Subpart 646-9 may result in fines, penalties and/or revocation of this Hauler registration.
8. Any hauler trailer that has been introduced into another waterbody prior to launching a boat into Lake George must be decontaminated prior to that trailer entering Lake George.
