**SUBJECT: RESOLUTION DETERMINING NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT AND
ISSUING A NEGATIVE DECLARATION UNDER SEQR FOR PROPOSED
REGULATION 6 NYCRR §646-5 “STREAM CORRIDOR MANAGEMENT”**

WHEREAS the Lake George Park Commission is empowered pursuant to Article 43 of the Environmental Conservation Law to preserve, protect and enhance the unique, natural and scenic resources of Lake George and to promulgate rules and regulations in furtherance of these purposes; and

WHEREAS the Commission must evaluate all proposed actions submitted to it for its consideration that may affect the environment in light of the State Environmental Quality Review Act (“SEQRA”) and the regulations promulgated thereunder, and

WHEREAS by Resolution 2020-13, adopted on April 28, 2020, the Commission adopted a resolution stating that the Final EIS dated May 26, 2009, took into account all of the environmental issues and concerns on the 2009 stream corridor regulations and is therefore applicable to comply with SEQR for the 2020 proposed regulations, and

WHEREAS by Resolution 2020-27, adopted on June 23, 2020, the Commission found the project to be an Unlisted Action as that term is defined in Section 6 NYCRR 617.2 and 617.4 and further named itself lead agency for the purposes of SEQRA; and

WHEREAS no interested or involved party objected to the Commission’s desire to serve and act as the lead agency for the purposes of SEQR; and

WHEREAS the Commission has taken a hard look at the project and examined and completed Part 2 and Part 3 of the Short Environmental Assessment Form;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners that the proposed project will not have a significant adverse effect on the environment for the reasons set forth in the attached Notice of Determination of Non-Significance and be it further

RESOLVED that the Executive Director, Staff and LGPC Counsel are authorized to take all actions reasonable and necessary to file the Negative Declaration and discharge the Commission’s responsibility as lead agency for this action.
