- WHEREAS the Lake George Park Commission is the New York State Agency charged with the long-term protection of Lake George and its many users, and
- WHEREAS Bruce Young, lifetime resident of Huletts Landing on Lake George, served as a Lake George Park Commissioner from 1996 until his passing in 2022, and
- WHEREAS Bruce served with distinction and honor as the Commission's Chairman for 20 years, the longest tenure of any Chairman in Commission history, and
- WHEREAS in his 20 years as Chairman of the Commission, Bruce directed the agency through some of the most important environmental protection and public safety initiatives in the agency's history, including cutting edge aquatic invasive species prevention, stormwater management, stream corridor protections, Marine Patrol expansions and a newly constructed office facility securing the future of the Commission, and
- WHEREAS Chairman Young was a highly respected leader in the Lake George Region, always open to new ideas, a consummate listener with a quick wit and a steady hand, and
- WHEREAS under Bruce's tenure as Chairman, the Commission has been made stronger, and Lake George itself has been better protected than at any time in history,

Now Therefore Be It Resolved that the Lake George Park Commission Board of Commissioners and staff hereby honor and acknowledge the significant accomplishments that Bruce Young has achieved in his tenure at the Commission, and

Also Resolved That the Commission recognizes Chairman Young for his considerable efforts, always giving generously of his time and talents, with the lasting protection of the Lake George basin and its waters his unwavering, guiding principle,

And Finally, Be It Resolved That Bruce Young's legacy as Chairman and as a conservation leader shall forever be a superior example for watershed protection and lake management in the Lake George Region and beyond.
