

RESOLUTION 2022-16

WHEREAS the Lake George Park Commission is empowered pursuant to Article 43 of the Environmental Conservation Law to develop regulations pertaining to wastewater treatment systems in the Lake George Park; and

WHEREAS improperly functioning wastewater treatment systems (“septic systems”) can have deleterious impact upon public health and nearby waterbodies including Lake George; and

WHEREAS in the summer of 2021, the Commission formed an Ad-Hoc Committee comprised of representatives from NYS DEC, NYS DOH and local municipalities, as well as engineers and subject matter professionals to research and investigate the need for a proactive inspection program for septic systems within proximity of Lake George; and

WHEREAS by Resolution 2022-01 dated January 25, 2022, the Commission determined the project to be a Type 1 Action as that term is defined in Section 6 NYCRR 617.2 and 617.4 and further named itself lead agency for the purposes of SEQR: and

WHEREAS no interested or involved party objected to the Commission’s desire to serve and act as the lead agency for the purposes of SEQR; and

WHEREAS the Commission has taken a hard look at the project and examined and completed Parts 2 and 3 of the Full Environmental Assessment Form;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that by the Board of Commissioners that the proposed project will not have a significant adverse effect on the environment for the reasons set forth in the attached Notice of Determination of Non-Significance and be it further

RESOLVED that the attorney for the Executive Director, Staff and LGPC Counsel are authorized to take all actions reasonable and necessary to file the Negative Declaration and discharge the Commission’s responsibility as lead agency for this action.
